

15 Step Roofing Procedure

- 1. Remove the existing roofing system down to the wood surface.
- 2. Inspect roof deck for rot or damage and replace plywood as necessary (at a per sheet cost).
- 3. Install metal drip edge at eavestrough to prevent animal damage and reduce moisture penetrating the wood roof deck.*
- 4. Install ice and water shield at eavestrough.*
 - Please advise if there are existing problems with ice damming.
- 5. Install synthetic underlayment to the entire roof deck.*
 - Marlad highly recommends this step as it provides an extra layer of leak and ice protection and extends the life of the shingle.
- 6. Install new metal valleys with ice and water shield underneath.
- 7. Install new shingles in the style, colour and brand chosen by the customer and indicated on the quote.
- 8. Install new flashing for all plumbing stacks.
- 9. Install the following: new roof vents, new washroom and/or kitchen exhaust vents.*
- 10. Install new metal wall flashing for masonry walls.*
- 11. Install new factory painted metal chimney flashing.*
- 12. Clean out all eavestrough of roofing debris (excluding those with gutter guard).
- 13. Clean up all debris, including a magnet sweep to ensure the pick up of all loose nails.
- 14. Payment requested upon completion with no deposit required.
 - Payment methods include: cheque, e-transfer or credit card (Visa, MC).
- 15. Supply customer with Marlad's 10 year workmanship warranty.
- * These steps are optional and the individual costs will be outlined on your quote. Please contact Marlad with any questions.
- All other existing roof components (eg. skylights, furnace stacks, etc.) will be reused in the original condition, unless otherwise specified on the quote.
